Show Rules

- ABGA Sanctioned classes and rules apply. Show starts at 10:00am.
- **No** entry fees....early or late. However, must have entries in advance, (before 6:00 pm Saturday, May 20th) in order to appear in show catalog
- **No** pen fees
- Ribbon placing 1 through 5.
- SIMPLE, QUICK, and EASY WAY TO ENTER....just send us a list of registration numbers for the animals you will be showing and we will look on ABGA web site and do the rest for you. Entry forms are attached if you prefer to do them yourself.
- All animals must be on the grounds by 8:00 show day and checked in with show secretary immediately
- Dogs must be leashed
- Children's toys, scooters, bikes, etc. are not allowed in the general staging area of the show ring area, the photo area or where other exhibiter's goats are penned.

Check-in Procedures

- If no one is around you may unload your animals and then check them in asap
- All animals must be checked in before 8:00 am show day
- The original ABGA registration papers, or approved, unexpired ABGA temporary registrations must be available at time of check-in.
- Current health papers must be available for all animals. Out-of-state exhibitors must have a "State of Maine permit" easily obtained by calling Melissa at Maine Dept. of Ag at 287-3701 and a "Certificate of Veterinary Inspection" which you get from your vet.
- At some point prior to the show the barn manager will check health papers and animals

Animal Identification

- All ABGA registered goats must be ear tattooed. Non-registered goats must wear a USDA Scrapie tag.
- Each animal must be identified on the appropriate health certificate form.
- To avoid disqualification it is the owner's responsibility to ensure legible ear tattoos match the registration papers.

- Exhibitors must have in their possession the animal's original registration certificate at the time of the show or an unexpired ABGA temporary registration.
- The American Boer Goat Association is the only recognized registry for this show.

Health Requirements

- All animals must be healthy.
- Animals with visible signs of abscesses or other contagious diseases (pinkeye, sore mouth, ringworm, etc.) will be not be allowed in the barn.
- For situations not listed above the show committee disposition will be final.

Fees and Pen Information

- **NO** Entry fees and **NO** pen fees
- Pen sizes are 5' X 5', 5' X 10', and 10' X 10'
- One tack area will be provided per exhibitor
- Pens are assigned by show management. If you have special needs and / or wish to pen near another exhibitor, please indicate this with your entries. **DO NOT** change name cards on pens without permission from a show manager.

Camping

- Camping is allowed on the fairgrounds for a flat rate of \$25.00 for the weekend.
